- Other historical items that tell the story of Leisure World's past?

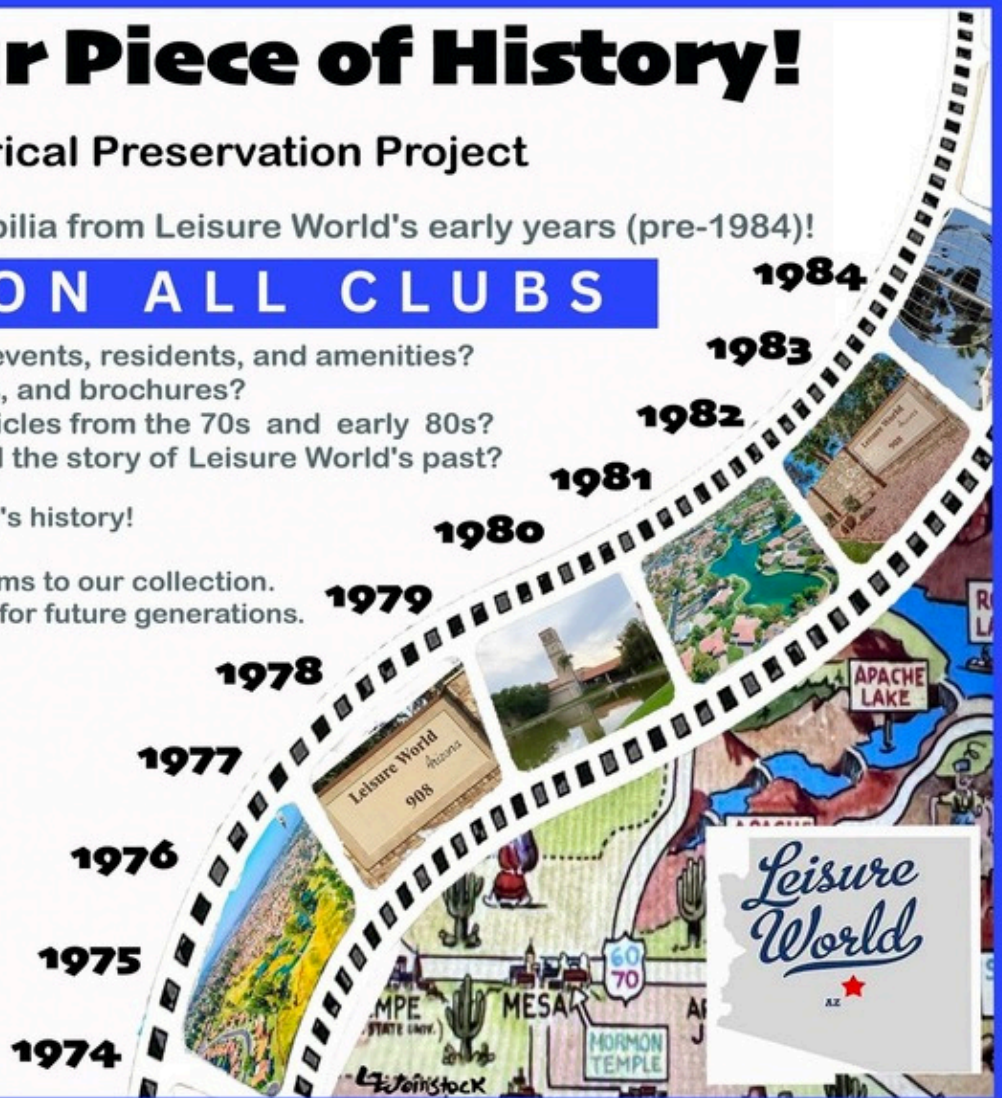

## AudioFetch Setup Instructions

\* If you are using hearing aids, you must have your hearing aids paired to your phone before AudioFetch is set up.

1. Download the Audio Fetch app from the App Store or scan the QR code and install.
2. Connect to the AudioFetch wifi (Ballroom, Theatre, Hopi/Pima), depending on the room you are in.
3. Open the AudioFetch app and select "Mics" for audio to start streaming on your phone
4. If you have trouble with AudioFetch showing the "Mics" button, please close and reopen AudioFetch.
